Currently Forest Dunes has 72 members and in 2010 they completed just over 10,000 rounds of golf. This represents a 20% increase from 2009. There is a tremendous opportunity to further increase membership and drive rounds at Forest Dunes. A new owner with a fresh approach to marketing should be able to leverage the work done by existing ownership to take Forest Dunes to the next level of economic success. Current ownership has spared no expense in operating the facility and a new owner should be able to cut expenses without sacrificing the quality of conditions and service.

Forest Dunes Living is a high end residential community, with unlimited potential to become a highly sought after four season vacation retreat. The infrastructure is in place for all of Phase 1 which includes 105 lots that are developed and ready for sale. Phase 2 is entitled for development of at least 200 additional lots.

















The remaining 700 acres is un-entitled but has unlimited development potential for more housing and golf. A new owner with a fresh approach to marketing the residential portion of the project will surely be able to surpass the historical lot sales achieved by present ownership. Also included are seven completed and fully furnished homes, ranging in size from 1,997 to 2,428 square feet, which serve as accommodations for overnight stays.

Only North America's Great Lakes region could produce the sand dunes, pine forests, birch groves and grasslands that authenticate the name Forest Dunes. The Tom Weiskopf Signature Course design is a brilliant homage to golf at its purest.

The challenge to players of all experience levels is as varied as the golf and lake views enjoyed from woodland homes that are barely visible from the course. Featuring generous landing areas and grassy greenside bailouts, Forest Dunes is inviting for golfers of all skill levels. The course length varies with six tee placements stretching the layout from 3,000 yards at the junior tees to 7,100 from the tips. There's also a 19th hole, complete with a mid-green bunker, on which a "score" may be settled. Members and their guests can brush up on their technique at the 20-acre practice facility, which features a dual-ended driving range, bunkered greens and a short game area that encourages practice from uneven lies.




Real Estate Information

Forest Dunes offers a wide variety of residential properties including Waterfront homesites on Lake AuSable, Championship Golf Park views along the Tom Weiskopf golf course and Wooded Preserve homesites. There are also a selection of custom homes, custom pre-designed golf cottages and fractional home ownership interests to choose from. The property types are classified as:

Lake AuSable homesites: Estate homesites from ½ - 1 acre, many with lakefront and beach club frontage with views spanning our 26-acre fresh water lake. Pricing is from \$195,000 -\$265,000.

Championship Golf Park homesites: These are estate homesites from ¹/₂ - 1 acre found along many of the striking golf course Fairways at Forest Dunes. Long range views over several fairways at Once typify these custom homesites, and many look beyond the golf course over neighboring Huron National Forest and the Mason Tract. These sites typically offer the greatest privacy from other neighbors and range from \$60,000 - \$225,000.



Custom Golf Cottage Homes: Cottage Homes at Forest Dunes will be reminiscent of cabins and lodge homes built throughout the Great Lakes region for generations. These homes showcase local materials and designs using Craftsman, Adirondack, Victorian, and lodge style architecture that embrace the local heritage and complement outdoor living. Cottage homes are typified with large common areas for get-togethers with friends and family around beautifully appointed kitchens, and all have spacious outdoor terraces for entertaining through the long summer evenings. These will typically be very low maintenance residences and low impact on the surrounding natural environment. Currently there are 7 homes available for sale with asking prices ranging from \$325,000 to \$489,000.
