



- Drop off service roads and cart paths at nearest point of relief ONE club length no nearer to hole, no penalty.
- Free drop nearest relief within ONE club length no nearer to hole from small trees and mole runs.
- Ring pipes on #2 to warn players on tee safe to hit.
- Keep carts on paths and in rough as much as possible, DO NOT drive down hills on 6,8,9.
- 6. Repair ball marks on greens.
- 7. Small Pine Trees-150 yds.
- 8. Winter rules on fairway only.
